

NOTICE:

You can now renew your WV pesticide licenses online at <http://www.kellysolutions.com/wv/applicators/erenewals/login.asp> Applicators can renew online as early as November 1 every year, providing their license is eligible for renewal. You must earn 20 credits per category every three years.

Your **username** is your license number. Certified public applicator license numbers begin with the letter "O" not the number zero.

Your password is the first three letters of your last name (case sensitive) + the last four digits of your social security number. Be sure you check the "I accept" box and enter your email address.

EXAMPLE:

Username: **O01234**

Password: **Mar3346**

As a government employee you do not pay a fee to renew your license, so this is an easy way to renew. If you no longer work for a government entity and wish to maintain your license, please contact our office for an application to become a certified applicator. The fee for this license is \$10.00.

Paper renewals will be mailed before December 31st. Any changes - such as: mailing address, phone number, email address or your company name, will need to be sent to our office in writing (email or fax is acceptable). If you need any assistance please feel free to call our office.
