Please fill out your project book neatly, complete each line, and please use complete sentences. When doing optional activities, write your response on a separate sheet of paper and staple in project book on page where activity is listed. Use different color ink or high-lighter for years 2 & 3. Directions to Show Site Trinity Lutheran Church, Arden. (Watch for Signs)

Trinity Lutheran Church Park is located on Pitzer Chapel Road, west of Arden. From Nollville take the ridge road to Arden, turn right onto Pitzer Chapel Road, ¼ mile on right.

From Inwood take the Arden-Nollville Road. In the small community of Arden go through both stop signs, turn left at Arden U.M. Church, go straight through the intersection onto Pitzer Chapel Road, ¼ mile on right.

From I-81 exit 8 go west toward Arden, at bottom of hill turn right, go straight at stop sign, turn left at Arden U.M Church, go straight through the intersection onto Pitzer Chapel Road, ¼ mile on right.
